GENERAL GRANT ROUND INFORMATION

Thanks to GIVE Wangaratta, Madge Brown Charitable Trust, and Wangaratta RSL funding is now available for Grants of up to \$5,000^{*} for charitable/community organisations that support priorities for local people. Give Wangaratta has a particular focus on supporting those in our community that are vulnerable including young people and families. Projects that fall within the following areas of interest will be eligible:

- Education, aspiration and development pathways towards employment
- Health and well-being, including mental health initiatives
- Housing and homelessness
- Support for vulnerable children, youth & families
- Respectful relationships, mentoring and community initiatives in response to violence
- Gambling, addiction and well-being support initiatives

Applicants must demonstrate their <u>charitable purpose</u> and explain how they will provide broad community/public benefit.

* Grant applications for larger projects up to \$10,000 maybe considered and we strongly support collaboration with other funders to achieve greater community impacts for targeted issues.

We recommend applicants seeking larger grants contact the Executive Officer, Into Our Hands Community Foundation to discuss your project prior to submission.

Eligible projects could include:

- A community event
- A health and well-being project
- An education project.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a grant, proposals must be submitted by community groups or

organisations that operate in the Rural City of Wangaratta local government area.

The project must be:

- a. Located or Implemented In the above Local Government Area
- b. Completed within the timeframe specified within your application which should be a maximum of 18 months.
- c. Agree to provide a Final Project Report within 1 month of the completion of your project
- d. Charitable in purpose and provide broad community benefit. It is helpful to hold Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) Item 1 charitable status but is not a requirement for this funding.

COMPLETING THE GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS

A simple online form is available and takes an estimated 10-20 minutes to complete.

Please have the following information before commencing:

- 1. Your organisation details including ABN number (where applicable).
- 2. Details if you are an ACNC registered charity or DGR registration, or details of

your auspicing organisation with which you have partnered.

If you do not have these details please contact Into Our Hands Foundation

to discuss other options before completing your application

 A brief description of your project. Please have this saved in a document ready to upload during the application process.

The following information should form part of your description:

- Name of your Organisation
- Project name
- Aim of project and its intended beneficiaries
- Value of the grant for which you are applying (Maximum of \$5,000)
- Project anticipated start date and estimated end date
- Details of any other organisations with which you are partnering.
- A "Budget Summary" of your project estimates of income or other funding contributions together with expenditure required to complete your planned project

All applications must be received by Into Our Hands Foundation by 5.00pm on the closing date Monday 8 May 2023. Late applications will not be considered.

Applications will be assessed on their merits and eligibility.

Grants will be awarded following a review by the GIVE Wangaratta selection panel and funding partners.

Successful applicants will be notified and formally announced.

All applicants will be notified in writing of the final funding decision.
